Revised Schedule:

- **20th January 2021** (50 students) - **Sl.No. 01 to 50**
- **21st January 2021** (50 students) - **Sl.No. 51 to 100**
- **22nd January 2021** (49 students) - **Sl.No. 101 onwards**

1. All students should report as per the following revised schedule with negative RTPCR report done in 72 hours prior to arrival.
2. This plan of staggered reporting to the campus has been done in a view of Covid-19 pandemic and safety of the students.
